

# Sanctioned Event Application – Users Guide

## Purpose

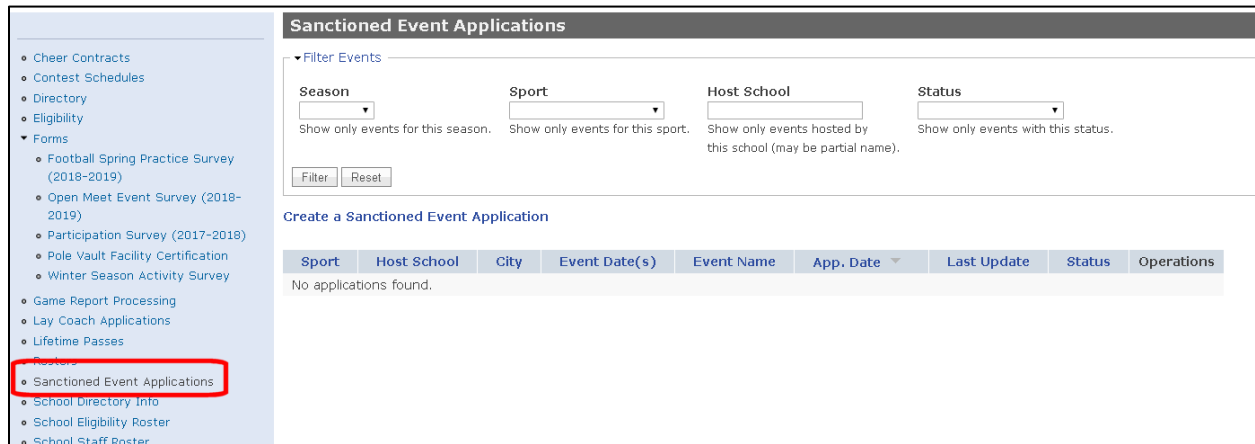

The sanctioned event application program allows applications for sanctioned events to be entered and processed online.

## Getting Started

---

Click the **Sanctioned Event Applications** link on the system menu. The system dashboard will be displayed – all applications will be displayed there along with their current status:

## Create an Application

---

Click the **Create a Sanctioned Event Application** link to create a new sanctioned event application. The following form will be presented:



The next page is where (optionally) invited Non-GHSA and/or border state schools are added:

### Create a Sanctioned Event Application

---

#### Non-Member Georgia Schools Invited

Schools invited to the event that are located in Georgia, but are not members of the GHSA

---

#### Border State Schools Invited

Schools from bordering states that have been invited to the event

In order to add a school, enter:

School Name

School City (and state for border state schools)

School Athletic Association

then press the "Add School" button. Once all of these schools have been added, click the Next button.

The final page of the application form is a statement of the GHSA policies on sanctioned events. The user must check the box signifying agreement with the policies.

### Create a Sanctioned Event Application

Sanctioning Policy

I agree to the stipulations below:

1. Each school guarantees its membership is in good standing in its own state high school association and also guarantees that participation in this contest shall not violate any standard of that association. The sanction is void if such membership has been terminated or if participation is found to be contrary to the state or national rules.
2. Each participant shall be eligible under the rules of his or her home state association.
3. Awards shall be limited to those permitted by the state association with the most restrictive award rule.
4. No entry shall be accepted for any competitor from any state or section not included in the list of states from which sanction is received.

Click the “Save Application” button in order to save the application. The application will then be added to the current list of Sanctioned Event Applications.

## Sanction Application Processing - Signature

When an application is created, its status immediately becomes “Not Signed” as shown below.

Next, the application must be signed by the principal or headmaster of the host school. No further application processing should take place until the application is signed. The user will be notified via email that an application is waiting to be approved.

In order to sign an application, the authorizing user must login with his/her credentials and access the application list. The list will display a “sign” link for those applications that require approval.

When the user accesses the “sign” link, the following form will appear (details of the application are left out here - the user will see the entire application):

**I agree to the stipulations below:**

1. Each school guarantees its membership is in good standing in its own state high school association and also guarantees that participation in this contest shall not violate any standard of that association. The sanction is void if such membership has been terminated or if participation is found to be contrary to the state or national rules.
2. Each participant shall be eligible under the rules of his or her home state association.
3. Awards shall be limited to those permitted by the state association with the most restrictive award rule.
4. No entry shall be accepted for any competitor from any state or section not included in the list of states from which sanction is received.

Checking this box signifies your endorsement of the event and GHSA policies governing GHSA sanctioned events.

Cancel Save Application Signature

By checking the endorsement box and pressing the Save button, the user signs the application.

## Sanction Application Processing – GHSA Approval

Once an application is signed, its status becomes “Signed”:

The list of applications contains filters for sport, host, and status so that applications can be easily located in the list. Sorting the list by clicking on headers is also available:

Once the GHSA office makes a determination on the event, a decision will be posted and you will be notified via email. If approved, the event will be posted on the Sanctioned Events page on the GHSA website.
